PROSPECTIVE EARLY YEARS PARENT TOURS FOR PLACES IN SEPT 2026

Essex County Council's application window for Reception/Early Years places for Sept 2026 opens on 10th November 2025 and closes on 15th January 2026. The system does not work on a first come first served basis, so as long as your application is in by the 15th January then your preferences will be acknowledged in the same way as those registered on the 15th November. Our school tours are booked on the following days:

REMINDERS
