START & FINISH OF SCHOOL

Our school gates will open as normal at 8.45am, we will be continuing to open the classroom doors at 8.55 so children can come in early ready for 9am registration. Please ensure that your children stand with you on the playground whilst waiting, rather than chasing around the playground! It is still expected that parents should be with their children on the playground, unless they are Y6/5 and walking to school independently. Y5/6 should be waiting sensibly near their classroom doors. The gates will be closing at 9am, our official registration time, so any latecomers will need to enter via the school office. Scooters should be wheeled on the school pathway and playground and not ridden. We do not have staff on playground duty at this time.

For home time the school gates will open at 3.05pm for the 3.15pm pick up time.

BEING READY FOR SCHOOL!

Please ensure your child is wearing school uniform (including plain red or grey cardigans/sweatshirts ~ not 'hoodies') and school shoes. Trainers are needed in PE kits. Don't forget to name your child's belongings!

Your child needs a water bottle, PE Kit, coat (suitable for weather conditions)

Packed Lunch bag/box or school dinner booked. All dinners need to be booked on line using School Comms. You need to be in credit to book dinners. Please remember any inhalers/medication etc that your child needs at school and hand them in at the office.

If you have found any school reading or library books 'hanging around' at home please ensure they are returned to school!

If you have any school uniform that no longer fits and would be suitable for 'handing on' please can you consider donating to school so we can help out other families.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

We are very much hoping to restart After School Clubs later this half term so please keep an eye out for the Club letter. We will not be using the School Comms app to book after school clubs.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Please ensure that you have booked places at Breakfast Club if you need them. Gates are opened at 8am and closed at 8.15am. Children can choose from a range of cereal, toast, yoghurts and fruit juice. You need to be in credit to book sessions.
